GPPAC Board

GPPAC's Board consists of seven members who are appointed upon nomination by the GPPAC International Steering Group (ISG). Members of the GPPAC Board serve for a period of three years, which can be renewed once. For more information about our current Board members, please [click here](#).

Remuneration Policy

Director salaries are determined by the GPPAC Board and are in accordance with remuneration guidelines (Code Wijffels), ensuring that a Director's salary does not exceed that of a Dutch Ministry Director General in the civil service (schaal 19 of the Bezoldigingsbesluit burgerlijke rijksambtenaren (BBRA)). Henceforth and in continuation from January 1st, 2014, no Stichting GPPAC employee will receive a salary that exceeds the amount mentioned above.

¹ Public Benefit Organisations (PBOs) are offered a number of tax advantages:

- A PBO does not pay Dutch inheritance tax or gift tax on inheritances or gifts that the institution allocates to the general good.
- A PBO does not pay Dutch gift tax on gifts that the institution makes for the general good.
- Natural and legal persons making donations to a PBO may deduct their gifts from their Dutch income tax or corporate income tax.
